

# **RULES OF THE GAMES**

## **HIGH SCORE**

For 1 to 8 players. Every player throws 3 darts in a round, for 7-10 rounds. The winner is the one with the highest total.

## **LOW SCORE**

The same as HIGH SCORE, except that the winner is the one with the lowest total.

## **SUPER SCORE**

The same as HIGH SCORE, except that points are only counted if they are doubles or trebles.

## **SCRAM**

Played in pairs, 7 rounds, 3 darts a round. All the numbers scored by the first player in the pair (the stopper) can't be scored by the second player of the same pair (the scorer). To score points, the second player has to choose some numbers that the first player hasn't hit. Each player in a pair takes turns to be stopper and scorer.

## **SHANGHAI**

Game for 1 to 8 players, 3 darts a round, for 7 rounds. All numbers have to be hit in order, from 1 to 20, finishing with bull. The winner is the player with the best score, or the first to reach first to SHANGHAI, that is, who in a single round gets the three numbers needed in three different sectors, that is in the simple, double and treble.

## **ROULETTE**

Played for 7 rounds, three darts a round. The roulette light begins to move and stops at one number from 1 to 20 or in the bull. The players throw at this number. A simple hit counts 1, a double 2 and treble 3 points.

## **PUB GAME**

For 1 to 8 players, three darts per round. A number that reduces is seen on the cricket diodes: it starts with number ten (10), the numbers gained with the throws are multiplied by this number, and the thrower has to throw the arrows at the board as fast as he can. The winner is the player with the highest score.

## **SUPER 100**

A game from 1 to 8 players, 3 darts a round. Every player has a score of 100 at the beginning. The board light moves clockwise. The player has to hit one of the segments in the lighted zone. If a sector is correctly hit, the player gets ten points from each player who has only points and has not been disqualified. If the player misses with one dart, he receives no points; if he misses with all three points in one round, he is out of the game, and his remaining points are lit up until the end of the game. When a player loses all his points, he is also out of the game. At the end of the game, all the points lit up are given to the winner. When all players except one are disqualified, the remaining player is the winner.

## **SOLO**

A game for only one player, up to 10 rounds. By pressing the SOLO button, the player can choose between HI SCORE and 301. After the game, the machine will assign the player a HANDICAP NUMBER, informing him of the level he has achieved in the game. The handicap number can be used for the classification of players at the beginning of a game. The lowest handicap is 0, and the highest is 99.

## **BASEBALL**

A game for from 1 to 8 players, with three darts per round. The player has to hit the sector the number of which corresponds to the current round, and no other sector is counted as 1 point, in a double as 2 and a treble as 3.

## **301 PARCHESI**

A game for from 1 to 8 players, 3 darts per round. Every player at the beginning has 0 points. Points gained during throwing are added to the initial result. When a player during throwing one dart gets the same points as another player the score of this other player is

taken away, and he has 0 points. In the case of team games, only players who belong to the other team can have cancellation of scores. The first player to achieve exceeds 301, this is a BUST, and the amount of the new score for this player is the difference between 301 and the score that is too high.

### **180**

A game for from 1 to 8 players, with three darts per round. Every player at the beginning has 180 points. Points gained during throwing are subtracted from the initial result. The first player, which reaches zero (0), is winner.

### **180 DOUBLE IN**

The same as 180, except that subtraction must and with a double.

### **180 DOUBLE IN / DOUBLE OUT**

The same as 180, except that subtraction has to begin and end with a double.

### **180 MASTER**

The same as 180 except that the game has to end in a double or a treble.

301, 501 and 701

These games are the same as 180, except that the game begins at 301, 501 or 701.

### **CRICKET**

A game for 1 to 8 players, with 3 darts a round. The players have to throw at the 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 sectors, and the bull. Every numbers is closed when the player has got it three times. A hit in a closed number is counted only if some other player has not hit it at all. The first player to close all six numbers and the bull and has the highest score is the winner.

### **CRICKET CUT THROAT**

The same rules as for CRICKET, except that hits in closed numbers give points to other players who still have that number open. The winner is the player with the least number of points, and has filled everything up.
